## GOAT Noat for May: Environmental Victories in the Maryland Assembly

- ➤ Greenhouse Gas Emissions Reduction Act (GGRA) Reauthorization (HB610/SB323) requires a 40% reduction in greenhouse gas emissions by 2030. Governor Hogan signed into law.
- Clean Energy Jobs Act (HB 1106/SB 921) increases Maryland's clean electricity standard – wind and solar – to 25% by 2020 and creates a dedicated clean energy jobs and business development program. Passed the General Assembly by large margins. Urge Governor Hogan to sign into law: org.salsalabs.com/o/423/p/dia/action3/common/public/? action KEY=19561
- ▶ Pollinator Protection Act aka Pesticides or "Neonics" bill (HB211/SB198) requires a warning on plants that have been treated with neonicotinoids (neonics) and doesn't allow sale of these pesticides to consumers. Neonics have been confirmed to play a significant role in the alarming decline of bees and other pollinators. Passed the General Assembly. Urge Governor Hogan to sign into law: sierra.force.com/actions/Maryland? actionId=AR0034950
