Library Committee Annual Report for 2017 Submitted February 4, 2018

The Library Committee did not meet during much of 2017. With some new members, we started meeting monthly in September. Due to the long hiatus and new membership, the committee is still trying to find its way forward. Much of our time has been spent talking about how the library fits into the Homewood Friends Meeting community. Each member has ideas; they have not yet coalesced into a clear path. Our main topics have been the purpose of the library, ways to make the space more inviting, and re-introducing the Meeting to the library. The Meeting has recently acquired a computer for the library and so we have also considered how to utilize the computer and to make our online catalogue accessible for the Meeting.

We hope to make the Library a place where more people feel welcome, whether to use the collection of materials or for silence and reflection.
