Accomplishments and On-going Tasks:

- Gutter Repairs we have had on-going problems with the north side gutters by the
 kitchen door and the south side gutters by the side porch. We have tried a couple of
 less expensive repairs, but they have not solved the problems. We are currently
 reviewing a proposal from Fick Roofing to rebuild both gutters. They did a similar job on
 another part of the roof in 2011 so we are hopeful they will be able to resolve our
 current issues.
- Kitchen Stove After a couple of scary incidents and an assessment by a stove person we decommissioned the old stove. We are working on getting a replacement.
- Brick repointing We are working on getting the outside stairs to the dining room repointed and repaired.
- New Cleaning Service Diamondz and Pearlz is doing a good job and is now handling filling the paper towel and soap dispensers.
- Unlocking the vault The new cleaning crew locked the vault as had not done in a very long time. We were not sure how to get it open until Rachael was looking in the office and saw a very old Roledex and happened to look under V for vault and there was the combination! Amazing! (We have locked the door in an open position so hopefully this will not happen again.)
- Mitchell Blinds repaired some blinds in the meeting room
- Whiteford Floors came and recoated the dining room floor.
- New AC for the office we removed the very old AC after it failed and put in a new one.
- Sump pump After the sump pump failed, we pumped a foot of water out of the sub-basement and had a new sump pump installed.
- Free standing sign out front We had the electric to the sign repaired and brought up to code.
- Elevator we had Preferred Elevator come do the pre-test inspection and then successfully passed our annual test.
- Boiler we passed our annual inspection

- Landscaping we maintained the garden by the side porch and are working with the GOAT committee on the new landscaping and rain barrel project.
- Changing the smoke detector batteries This is not as easy as it sounds but we finally got them changed and got rid of the chirping.
- Unclogged sinks Rachael unclogged the sink in the women's bathroom
- Repaired the utility sink We had a broken faucet replaced in the utility sink.
- Fixed light in the nursery Rachael and David handled this tricky problem.
