Minutes for Sunday, November 11, 2018

Meeting began with silent worship at 1:00pm.

Minutes of October 15, 2018 meeting were approved with two amendments. “totally over \$10,000” appears to be a typo for “totaling over \$10,000.” Also, Jo Brown recalls us discussing the relative merits of giving larger amounts of money to fewer organizations, and the fact that smaller donations entail a larger percentage going to processing/accounting fees.

Budget for FY 2018: From the \$1300 of remaining funds, those present would like to approve giving \$500 to Esperanza Immigrant Legal Services, \$400 to Alternatives to Violence, and \$400 to Baltimore Community Mediation Center.

Budget for FY 2019: We would like to zero out Clay Pots and allocate the \$300 to Esperanza Immigrant Legal Services. We also considered the idea of retaining some of the P&S funds from 2019 for an activity led by Homewood Friends.

Wicker Basket: Paul’s Place seems like a good idea for December/January. We discussed the idea of alternating between national and local organizations. Is that necessary/advisable? How much money does Whicker Basket typically generate?

Meeting for 2nd Sunday in December. Confirmed for December 9th.

Christmas/Peace Vigil. Hold both on Friday, December 14th.

We did not have time to discuss the new items (Baltimore Yearly Meeting Peace Committee and AFSC).
