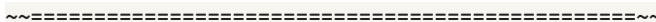

Homewood's own local Spiritual Formation will begin with a potluck formation in September, stay tuned for sign up info.

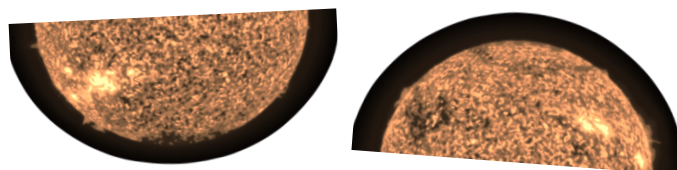


FOOD DONATIONS
