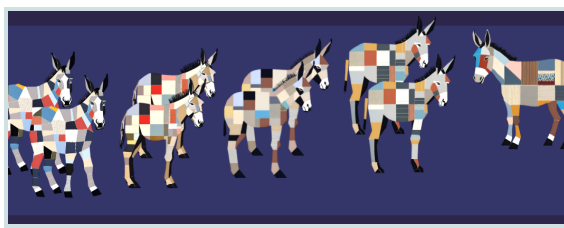

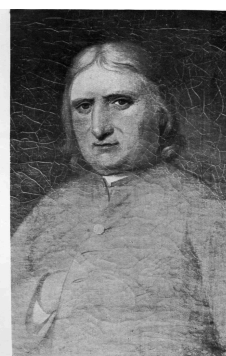
WELCOMING GABRIELLE: Sunday 7/14 12:30
